By making these connections real to everyone, it is designed to spur citizen involvement and activity to help protect the bay's health and resources.

The campaign messages engage citizens in bay stewardship and direct them to the campaign web site www.ThankYouDelawareBay.org that lists action items and serves as a "portal" to Delaware Bay information on many other web sites including how to learn about and where to experience the bay, the impacts of daily decisions on bay life, bay conservation issues, and what to do to help the bay.
